Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic School, a PK3-8 elementary school located in the Love Field neighborhood of Dallas, TX, announces its search for an experienced, energetic, and effective administrator to serve as its next principal. The position is effective July 2023 unless the successful candidate is found beforehand. A full position profile and job description will be available in the coming weeks. Below is brief overview of the School.

Founded in 1946 as a ministry of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church, the School has assisted families in the Catholic formation of their children and has educated students to become responsible citizens and committed Catholics for 75 years. Projected enrollment for 2022-2023 is for approximately 150 students. Early learning at Our Lady of Perpetual Help is Montessori inspired, offering a program that encourages independent growth through hands-on, developmentally appropriate materials. This program is directed by the Sisters from the Order of the Daughters of the Sacred Heart and is highly regarded throughout the Diocese. Our Lady of Perpetual Help is an English-language immersion school, and the Diocesan curriculum serves as a model for content and pacing at each grade level. Prayer is integral to the School's daily life.

Applications are now being accepted. Minimum requirements include: 1) Practicing Catholic; 2) Proficiency in speaking Spanish; 3) Advanced degree in Educational Administration/Leadership or Principal Certification (may be in-progress), and 4) Five (5) years' experience as a principal or assistant principal (Catholic school preferred).
