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
A LETTER FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT

Education is about more than test scores and academic outcomes. Catholic schools provide an exemplary education for students of all faiths in a nurturing environment that supports each child's development as a whole person.

1. Your child will be part of a community.

We believe that young people flourish when they are part of a community. Our Catholic schools are made up of students of diverse faiths, races, ethnicities, talents, and interests. With 37 different Catholic schools from grades PreK-12 in Dallas and beyond, students can find a community that truly feels like home.

2. Your child will receive an exemplary education.

A Catholic education unlocks every student's potential, and forms students to be scholars who embrace a love of learning. Our students consistently outperform their peers across the state on ACT and College Placement tests. Across the nation, Catholic schools students demonstrate higher academic achievement than students from similar backgrounds in public schools. When we prioritize robust human formation instead of placing pressure on testing outcomes, our students thrive.

3. Your child will be embraced as a whole person, not simply ranked by test scores or grades.

Our Catholic school curriculum and culture are built on the understanding that children are more than their academic success. We want our students to be both saints and scholars- saints who love God and care for one another, and scholars who cultivate a love for learning and explore their unique passions.

4. With smaller classes, your child will be known and supported.

Smaller schools and classes give our Catholic school students a more personalized learning experience. Students can flex their leadership muscles through range of clubs and activities, student-led learning, and local and national academic, artistic, and athletic competitions. Teachers can more easily identify opportunities for students to receive academic enrichment, reading and math support, or other learning interventions, and maintain open communication with parents.

5. Your child's physical and mental wellbeing will be a priority every day.

Student health and safety have never been more important. Each of our Catholic schools has a detailed Crisis Management Plan in place to keep students and teachers secure, and by 2023, two adults on every campus will be trained in Youth Mental Health First Aid to care for students' mental and emotional needs.



ACCREDITATION

Students also take the CogAT or cognitive abilities test, which estimates students' learned reasoning and problem-solving skills.




