"Forming his disciples, Jesus entrusted to them "the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven"; he taught them how to pray; he opened his "meek and humble heart" to them; and he sent them "ahead of him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit. The fundamental task of catechesis is to achieve this same objective: the formation of disciples of Jesus Christ. Jesus instructed his disciples; he prayed with them; he showed them how to live; and he gave them his mission" (NDC, 20).
