

Catholic Identity Standards

PK3.0 The student understands and integrates the content of what is learned into their faith and daily life.

- PK3.0A recognize that every human life is sacred because each person is created and loved by God
- PK3.0B describe ways to take part in/be responsible to the community by discerning and using our God-given gifts
- PK3.0C recognize and oppose unjust social structures and work toward justice for all
- PK3.0D see God at work in all things and as expressed in the sacraments
- PK3.0E connect scripture, tradition, and the models of Mary and the saints to guide, grow, and deepen faith

Number Sense

- PK3.V.A.1 rote counts from 1 to 10
- PK3.V.A.2 counts up to 5 objects with one-to-one correspondence
- PK3.V.A.3 counts up to 5 items and demonstrates cardinality by communicating that the last number indicates how many items are in the set
- PK3.V.A.4 instantly recognizes the quantity of up to 3 objects without counting (subitizes)
- PK3.V.A.5 recognizes numerals 0-5
- PK3.V.A.6 represents quantities up to 5
- PK3.V.A.8 compares sets of objects up to 5 using comparative language (e.g., more than, less than, same number of)

Joining and Separating

- PK3.V.B.1 uses objects to demonstrate that adding one or more objects to a set will increase the number of objects in the set
- PK3.V.B.2 uses objects to demonstrate that taking away one or more objects from a set will decrease the number of objects in the set

Geometry and Spatial Sense

- PK3.V.C.1 names and describes common 2D shapes
- PK3.V.C.2 attempts to create shapes using materials and/or manipulatives
- PK3.V.C.3 begins to use language to describe position of objects
- PK3.V.C.4 recognizes common shapes, regardless of size

Measurement

- PK3.V.D.2 begins to recognize capacity based on how much space exists within an object
