Every student in our Catholic high schools will receive an academically excellent education; however, it is the preparation for life beyond college that sets these four years apart.

We couldn't be more excited that your family is considering taking the next steps on the journey to college and heaven in one of our Catholic high schools. Know of our prayers for you as you make this most important decision.

# WHY CATHOLIC EDUCATION

Education is about more than test scores and academic outcomes. Where can your child get prepared for the next level of learning and develop a readiness and resilience that will stay with them for their lifetime? Catholic schools provide an exemplary education for students of all faiths in a nurturing environment that supports each child's development as a whole person.

## **1. Your child will be part of a community**

With 37 different Catholic schools from grades PreK-12 in Dallas and beyond, students can find a community that truly feels like home.

A Catholic education unlocks every student's potential, and forms students to be scholars who embrace a love of learning. Across the state, students in our Catholic schools outperform their peers on SAT and AP tests. Across the nation, Catholic schools students demonstrate higher academic achievement than students from similar backgrounds in public schools. Whether learning online, in the classroom, or a mix of both, each of our Catholic schools has a robust e-learning platform that keeps students engaged in the curriculum and community.

## **3. Your child will be embraced as a whole person, not simply ranked by test scores or grades**

Our Catholic school curriculum and culture are built on the understanding that children are more than their academic success. National studies show that Catholic school graduates are more civically engaged, more tolerant for diverse views, more likely to vote, and more likely to volunteer in the community.

## **4. With smaller classes, your child will be known and supported**

Smaller schools and classes give our Catholic school students a more personalized learning experience. Students can flex their leadership muscles through range of clubs and activities, student-led learning, and local and national academic, artistic, and athletic competitions.
